The tour cost is only \$56 per person including lunch at the famous Buckhorn Exchange (includes meal taxes & wait-staff gratuity), transportation, guide, admissions, and tour-handouts. Like theater tickets, there are no cancellation refunds.

This six-hour tour is a perfect day outing for a person with limited mobility as there will be a limited number of times you will need to get on and off the coach.
